Curveball: Double Down — wrong	0	All points for that round are lost
Curveball: Steal	+2 from leader	Only if explanation of correct answer is strong enough
Curveball: Minority Report	+4	Awarded only if exactly one team is correct
Curveball: Plot Twist bonus	+2	Only if team changes to the correct answer after twist
